## FRENCH HORN AUDITION REQUIREMENTS

### **Bachelor of Music Education and/or Bachelor of Music degrees**

#### **Minimum requirements:**

Major scales and arpeggios - 7 flats and 7 sharps 2 octaves

Two contrasting etudes from any of the following:

Kopprasch - 60 Studies for Horn;

Pottag - Preparatory Melodies for Solo Horn

Maxime Alphonse – 200 New Melodic and Gradual Studies for Horn

1<sup>st</sup> movement from one of the following

W. A. Mozart Concerto No. 2, 3, or 4

R. Strauss – Concerto No. 1

F. Strauss – Concerto No. 1

C. Saint-Saens – Morceau de Concert
